



\$5,000 Guaranteed Multi-table Tournament Rules

The "5th Season Poker Open " multi-table tournament is a series of qualifying tournaments which will result in 30 players qualifying for the 5th Season Poker Open Championship tournament.

Qualifying tournament's will be held

1. Tuesday, January 19 — 6 p.m.
2. Wednesday, January 20 — 6 p.m.
3. Tuesday, January 26 — 6 p.m.
4. Wednesday, January 27 — 6 p.m.
5. Tuesday, February 2 — 6 p.m.
6. Wednesday, February 3 — 6 p.m.
7. Tuesday, February 9 — 6 p.m.
8. Wednesday, February 10 — 6 p.m.
9. Tuesday, February 16 — 6 p.m.
10. Wednesday, February 17 — 6 p.m.
11. CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT
Tuesday, February 23 — 6 p.m.

The tournament will be organized as follows:

1. Oaklawn will run 10 qualifying tournaments starting Tuesday, January 19th, 2010.
2. The top 3 players from each qualifying tournament will advance to the 5th Season Poker Open Championship Tournament scheduled for Tuesday, February 23rd at 6pm.
3. Buy-in amount \$25+\$10. Sign-ups at the Oaklawn Poker podium only. Must have exact buy-in amount. Sign-ups for each qualifying tournament will only be taken on the day of each tournament. Sign-ups start at 10am and ends when the qualifier field is full. If a player chooses to withdraw, they must do so by 4 p.m.
4. Oaklawn will accept one (1) Alternate from each qualifying tournament. In the event that the 4th place finisher is a winner of a prior qualifying tournament, the 5th place finisher will be taken as the alternate and so on until a suitable alternate is selected.

5. On the day of each tournament each player will draw to determine table number and seat number.
6. Qualifying tournament participants will receive \$2,000 in tournament chips to use for play in the tournament.

7. Prize money payout for each of the 10 qualifying tournaments will be paid to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place winners in each qualifying tournament (10% of the field). Payout is based on 40 players in each qualifying tournament.

8. Prize money for the championship round will be paid to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers (or 10% of the field).

Prize payout is as follows: 1st, \$3,000; 2nd, \$1,500; 3rd, \$500

9. First and second place winners from each qualifying tournament may enter other qualifying tournaments but may only win one seat in the championship. If the top 3 finishers have previously qualified for the Championship, the 4th and (if necessary) 5th place finishers will be awarded seats. If both the 4th and 5th place finishers also previously qualified, the same system will be used (6th and 7th place will be awarded seats, and so on) until both spots are filled.

Championship tournament will be held on Tuesday, February 23 at 6 p.m. The 30 qualifying players must confirm their seat when they qualify. Players must arrive for the championship round no later than 5:00pm. Alternates will be contacted to fill any spots not confirmed by 5 p.m.

Oaklawn's PokerPro system clock will be the official timekeeper. The Poker host will notify all players of breaks and table changes when necessary.

No re-buys.

Oaklawn will not facilitate chopping the pot between players and the tournament must be concluded with a champion before prize payouts are made.

Oaklawn poker management reserves the right to make changes to this promotion at any time. All decisions by Oaklawn poker management are final.
